New Heil Powerlinks for rural collections

Heil Europe has supplied Tynedale Council with a further 5 new Powerlinks which have been fitted with rear steer chassis for ease of manoeuvre in rural areas. The new refuse collection vehicles are being used for the collection of household refuse and recyclable waste and have been supplied by Londonderry Garage, who will be servicing the support requirements of the Heil equipment.



Tynedale looked at various chassis/body combinations and eventually specified the rear steer chassis option for ease of access into more 'harder to reach' rural locations.



The Heil Powerlink has more flexibility than most other RCV's and is available in a number of body sizes; Tynedale specified a Powerlink 21m³ body which offers a shorter vehicle length ideally suited for country lanes and rural areas with no lost available legal payload.

Tynedale Council is one of six district councils in Northumberland and with 857 square miles it has the largest rural district council area in England.

Philip Hindmarsh, Head of Waste and Transport Management for Tynedale Council said: "We chose to purchase the Heil Powerlinks because of delivery, warranty, quality of product and the support of a dealer with local engineers. We have been extremely impressed with the new Powerlinks."

The environment is of great importance to Tynedale Council which was another reason why the Heil Powerlink was the obvious choice. The newly designed

hydraulic system offers unique and unparalleled performance; reduced downtime; lower maintenance costs and less risk of environmental pollution.

The new Heil Powerlinks make up a total fleet of 8 front line refuse collection vehicles; 6 of which are Heil. Factory training courses have already been booked Tynedale engineers at Heil's factory in Fife, maintenance of the new Powerlinks will be carried out in-house.

New Eurocyclers help the environment

The Eurocycler is a relatively new product from Heil Europe, part of Heil Environmental Industries, the world's largest refuse collection vehicle manufacturer. Tried and tested in the United States for the past ten years, the Eurocycler enables fast and efficient handling of mixed and recyclable refuse.

The Eurocycler has a body length of 7.7 metres and a capacity of 25.3m³, which is split 11.6m³ in the top compartment, and 13.7 m³ in the bottom. A split container on both sides of the body allows the



simultaneous separation and dumping of recyclables into the body chambers from either side.

The Comb mechanism allows containers to be lifted ranging from 120 - 360 litres and with the added advantage of the unique detachable Panniers, you can use both sides for a box recycling system, or one side for boxes

and the other side for wheeled containers. The new Comb Lift can be fitted to one or both sides as an option to give complete versatility of operation.

Cushioned cylinders ensure a smoother, quieter operation while other benefits include Heil's unique dual swing link action packing mechanism.

Heil Powerlink – robust, reliable and cost effective!

According to Brian Jones, Transport and Environmental Waste Manager for Castle Morpeth Borough Council, the Heil Powerlink is a robust, reliable and cost effective piece of refuse collection equipment.

Castle Morpeth Borough Council took delivery of its first vehicle with Heil Powerlink compaction equipment in March 1999 and now has total of nine vehicles with Heil compaction bodies. Londonderry Garage has recently supplied the Borough Council with five new Heil Powerlinks which are being used for the collection of recycling and household refuse. The new Powerlinks have a range of carrying capacity from 16 to 22 cubic metres.

"Their performance has been excellent," says Brian Jones. "With our fleet of Heil units, the council is in a position where it can carry out its statutory duties in a confident, cost effective manner."

Brian continues: "The Powerlink is of a robust quality that can take the punishment of the ever-increasing demands of recycling and refuse collection. Having such reliable equipment has been key to our



success in having the highest household recycling rate in the region, way above the national average at 37%."

Castle Morpeth Borough Council has found that the Powerlinks have significantly reduced maintenance due to the packing mechanism, which is set up of links and hardened pins. This has reduced vehicle downtime in relation to the conventional equipment with slide block arrangement.

Along with normal domestic refuse collection, Castle Morpeth Borough Council offers kerbside recycling service of dry recyclables to the whole of the borough. Of those properties, 3,300 households are offered a green waste collection and 3,100 receive a doorstep glass collection service. These services will be extended to more properties this year. Castle Morpeth Borough Council also provides a weekly trade collection of residual and recycling waste.

H Brown & Son (recycling) Ltd order another Heil Big Bite

It offers a refuse carrying capacity of up to 31m³, which with the large 2.5m³ hopper, facilitates the collection of large refuse items and reduces the collection time for each trip by increasing the volume packed in each cycle. It can lift bins up to 1100 litres and with its programmable logic controls (PLC) the Big Bite offers simplified control, reliable operation and system conditioning monitoring.



Heil win contract after competitive tendering process



Coventry City Council has recently awarded leading refuse collection vehicle manufacturer Heil Europe with the contract to supply a further 16 Powerlink refuse collection vehicles.

Having recently taken delivery of 10 new Heil Powerlinks, and an existing fleet of 7 Heil vehicles, Coventry City Council will soon have a total of 33 Heil RCV's in their fleet.

The vehicles being supplied to Coventry City Council are Heil Powerlink 22m bodies fitted to a Mercedes Econic chassis. The new vehicles have been specified with Terberg Omnidel and high level

bin lifts for greater flexibility. The Powerlink bodies have also been fitted with drainage kit systems and the latest weighing system. All Heil vehicles are being used for the collection of recyclable, domestic and trade waste.
